## **Description**

This Prize was established by subscriptions from past and present students and staff of the Geology Department at Auckland University, as well as from other professional colleagues, as a tribute to Professor A. R. Lillie upon the occasion of his retirement after holding the Chair in Geology at Auckland from 1951 to 1974.

## Selection process

- Nomination is made to the Scholarships Office
- The Prize is awarded on the recommendation of the Director of the School of Environment

## Regulations

- 1. The Prize will be known as the Arnold Lillie Prize in Geology.
- 2. The value of the Prize will be \$600 and it will be awarded together with one appropriately inscribed bookplate.
- 3. The Prize is intended to encourage a high standard of field work by students of Geology at the University of Auckland.
- 4. The Prize will be awarded for the most meritorious report (including a thesis or course) on geological field work written in the year preceding the award by a student of the University (whether a graduate or undergraduate).
- 5. The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council upon the recommendation of the Director of the School of Environment.
- 6. The University of Auckland will not be bound to award the Prize in any year if there is no candidate of sufficient merit.
- 7. In the event of a tie, the Director of the School of Environment shall determine if the Prize may be shared.
- 8. The University of Auckland Council has the power to amend or vary these regulations provided that there is no departure from the main purpose of the Prize.
