Generic settings for devices connecting to UoA-WiFi using in-built wireless configuration service

Note: This guide is a list of generic settings for devices connecting to UoA-WiFi using in-built wireless configuration service.


1. Connecting to UoA-WiFi

Network Name (SSID)	UoA-WiFi
Security Type	WPA2-Enterprise or WPA2 with AES
Network Authentication Method	PEAP
Authentication Method	EAP-MSCHAPv2
Userid	UPI
Security certificate	AddtrustExternal CA Root Certificate
Server certificate	uoa-wifi.auckland.ac.nz

For most machines the setup process will be automatic, windows XP being the exception.

2. Trouble shooting

If your device does not automatically connect to UoA-WiFi you can manually install the security certificate for this connection as follows:

- Browse the following URL: <http://www.auckland.ac.nz/uoa/cs-wireless-network/?#s3c2>
- Select the following link:  [AddTrustExternal CA Root Certificate](#) (1 KB FILE) and follow the pop-up prompts.

Your device should now be able to connect to the UoA-WiFi network.
