Waipapa Taumata Rau Demographics 2023

Purpose

This document provides information about the diverse characteristics of students and staff at Waipapa Taumata Rau | University of Auckland.

Overview of 2023

For undergraduate and postgraduate students, the most commonly identified ethnic group is Asian, and the most commonly identified gender is female.

For academic and professional staff, the most commonly identified ethnic group is Pākehā/European, and the most commonly identified gender is female.

Senior academic and professional staff predominantly identify themselves as Pākehā or belonging to a European ethnic group, and senior academic staff predominantly identify themselves as male.

This overview is unchanged from 2022 as the demographic composition of our community is fairly stable.

Key Trends for 2021 – 2023

Waipapa Taumata Rau is experiencing gradual shifts in the demographic composition of student and staff communities.

Student Community

Shifts in the composition of the student community are mainly driven by undergraduate students. Since 2021 there have been steady increases in the percentage of students who:

- Identify themselves as belonging to an Asian ethnic group
- Disclose that they experience disability
- Come from a low decile school

There has also been a steady decrease in the percentage of students who identify themselves as being Pākehā or belonging to a European ethnic group.

Staff Community

Since 2021 there have been increases in the percentages of staff who:

- Identify themselves as belonging to a Pacific or an Asian ethnic group
- Disclose that they experience disability
- Identify themselves as belong to the LGBTQIATakatāpuiMVPFAFF+ community.

There has also been a steady decrease in the percentage of staff who identify themselves as being Pākehā or belonging to a European ethnic group.

Measurement classes:

- 1. Ethnicity
- 2. Gender
- 3. Disability
- 4. Refugee background
- 5. LGBTQIATakatāpuiMVPFAFF+ Rainbow
- 6. Constrained Economic Background (CEB).

Levels of reporting

Data in each class are reported at three levels:

- 1. University community
- 2. Student community
- 3. Staff community.

An exception to the levels of reporting is CEB, which is only reported at the student community level.

Data Presentation

Census data are presented for all measures, reflecting the number of people in each group.

Some people are both students and staff and will be counted twice.

Some people identify as belonging to more than one measurement class, and will be counted in each of them.

In general, data are accurate as of 9 April 2023. Student Community Qualification Completions and Academic Staff by Role data are accurate as of 26 April 2023.

The acronym LGBTQIATakatāpuiMVPFAFF+, and the term Rainbow, are used for lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, intersex and asexual – with:

- Takatāpui being a term embracing all Māori with diverse genders, sexualities, and sex characteristics.
- MVPFAFF embracing Pacific identities
 - Mahu Hawai'i and Tahiti
 - o Vaka sa lewa Fiji
 - o Palopa Papua New Guinea
 - o Fa'afafine Samoa
 - Akava'ine Rarotonga
 - o Fakaleiti Tonga
 - o Fakafifine Niue.

Other key terms and their abbreviations are set out on the final page of this document.

Chart 1.1A Student Community 2021 – 2023




Chart 1.1B Staff Community 2021 -2023



Chart 1.2A Undergraduate Student Community 2021 - 2023





Chart 1.2B Taught Postgraduate Student Community 2021 - 2023

Chart 1.5A Academic Staff 2021 - 2023





Chart 1.5B Professional Staff 2021 - 2023

Chart 2.1A Student Community by Gender 2021 - 2023




Chart 2.1B Staff Community by Gender 2021 - 2023




Chart 2.1C Student Community Characteristics 2021 - 2023




Chart 2.1D Staff Community Characteristics 2020-2022




Chart 2.2B Taught Postgraduate Student Community by Gender 2021 - 2023




Chart 2.2C Research Postgraduate Student Community by Gender 2021 - 2023




Chart 2.2D Undergraduate Student Community Characteristics 2021 - 2023




Chart 2.2E Taught Postgraduate Student Community Characteristics 2021 - 2023




Chart 2.2F Research Postgraduate Student Community Characteristics 2021 - 2023



Chart 2.5A Academic Staff by Gender 2021 - 2023




Chart 2.5B Professional Staff by Gender 2021 - 2023




Chart 2.5C Academic Staff Characteristics 2021 - 2023




Chart 2.5D Professional Staff Characteristics 2021 - 2023


