 - (ii) capacity to make or to communicate decisions relating to any aspect or aspects of their personal care and welfare; or
- (d) is a bankrupt—
 - (i) who has not obtained an order of discharge; or
 - (ii) whose order of discharge has been suspended for a term not yet expired
 - or is subject to conditions not yet fulfilled.
