

Social Policy

- Indicators/data analysis (FoRST)
 - Early 2000s Used Census to construct NZ Socio-Economic Index
 - 2000s Used Census to create <u>well-being monitor</u> of families

Simulation modelling (Marsden, MSI/MBIE)

- 2002 Modelling partnership patterns across Censuses
- Current Using existing studies to model family dynamics as policy tool

Health Policy

- Evaluation/data analysis (HRC)
 - Early 2000s National hospital safety and family doctor studies
 - Late 2000s <u>hospital</u> restructuring and hospital outcomes studies

- Simulation modelling (HRC)
 - 2000s modelling primary care in an ageing society.
 - Current modelling <u>health and social care needs</u> among elderly
