## Tū māia hei kiriwhakatauira mō ā tātou mokopuna

Explore holistic mokopuna development, specialist STEM curriculum, educational leadership, and research informed assessment practices. You will develop skills to teach effectively through te reo Māori while gaining practical experience in kura. Mātauranga Māori and international approaches are brought together in this programme to produce kaiako who can meet the unique needs of Kaupapa Māori and Māori-medium settings.



### The opportunity to earn while you learn!

Scholarships are available to students who meet the programme enrolment requirements\*.

Scholarships for successful students will cover university course fees and provide a \$12,500 stipend to support living costs, paid in instalments over 10 months.

Those selected will spend 3 days a week embedded in a host school where they will experience day-to-day school life from the very beginning of the year, benefiting from being part of a school community, learning alongside experienced teachers and immersing themselves in school activities.
