You will study courses designed to develop knowledge and understanding of high-quality learning and teaching by engaging with in-depth study about relational and inclusive pedagogies, and curriculum responsive to children, families, and communities.

Taught from our City Campus, this masters also includes two practicum courses, where students will develop teaching practice through a mix of in-centre days and block week practicum placements in early childhood centres.
