

Food Waste - Globally

If food waste were its own country, it would be the third largest Greenhouse Gas emitter

- KiwiHarvest is New Zealand's largest dedicated national food rescue social venture
- Established in 2012
- Branches in Auckland, North Shore, Dunedin and Queenstown
- Eight refrigerated vans on the road
- Strong established supply partnerships: Bidfood, Fonterra, Countdown, Foodstuffs, Unilever, Frucor Suntory, Turners & Growers, Gilmours, Balle Bros, Heinz Watties, Hello Fresh
- Servicing demand from 250 front line agencies across the country

New Zealand Food Network adopts a wholesale model:

An efficient end to end supply chain for surplus food (waste & donated)

Large scale producers, growers, wholesalers and pack houses

Send pallets or bins of bulk surplus food



Receive, unpack and re-pack bulk food, into cartons if appropriate

Food hubs

Receive free of charge pallets of food, likely mix of cartons













Supply partners send food to NZFN when they no longer need it and it still has a useful life

NZFN holds food in efficient temperature suitable storage until food hubs need it

Food hubs request food from NZFN as they need it, up to 5 times a week to meet demand

Food hubs only need sufficient infrastructure to receive and hold enough food to meet 1-2 days demand

We are currently partnered with over 50 Food Hubs* right across New Zealand, helping us get more food to people who need it most.














Food Categories by Weight (%)
