- Up to 30 points (2 courses) may be taken from any programme at this University including the BCom schedule.
- Double major requires at least 45 points (3 courses) at Stage III per major. If you are studying a single major you require 75 points (5 courses) at Stage III and course marked \*\* can be BCom Stage II or III.
