

Butland Award for Leadership in Teaching

Description	The Butland Award for Leadership in Teaching recognises and rewards leadership displayed by teaching staff at the Faculty of Medical and Health Sciences. Any teacher employed by the Faculty for at least a 0.5 FTE proportional contract is eligible to apply for this award, either as individuals or representing a group. Nominee/s need not hold appointed leadership roles. Previous award winners will be ineligible for re-nomination in the same category for six years.					
	The value of the award is \$2,000 which may be used for the purpose of further developing the awardee's academic interests and career via conferences, etc.					
Award Subcommittee	The award will be made by the Dean of the Faculty of Medical and Health Sciences on the advice of a subcommittee which will include the Chair, FMHS Education Committee; an undergraduate student representative; a postgraduate student representative; and representatives from the Schools in the Faculty of Medical and Health Sciences and Te Kupenga Hauora Māori.					
Method of Application	Potential recipients of a Leadership in Teaching Award must be nominated by at least two people, one of whom must be a member of the academic staff of the University and one of whom may be a current or former student (i.e., has been taught by the nominee/s within the last five years).					
	In making its recommendation the subcommittee will look for evidence of exceptional leadership in teaching that has had a transformative impact on teaching and learning in the Faculty of Medical and Health Sciences.					
	Evidence of teaching leadership is to be provided in the nominee's/nominee teaching portfolio. The portfolio should not be more than 6,000 words (i approximately 12 pages of single spaced text), and should be no smaller th 12 point font. The three one-page statements from the nominators are r included in the word count, but all other supporting information is. T subcommittee reserves the right not to consider portfolios that do not me these criteria. Guidance related to the portfolio may be drawn from page thr of the <u>University awards policy</u> .					
	Nominations may be accompanied by University course or lecturer evaluations (summarised) or other independent evaluations, course guides or any other supporting material. (Note: such material must be included within the page limits of the portfolio.)					
Selection criteria	 The Awards Sub-committee will take into account the following broad criteria: Substantial contributions to course and curriculum review or other development initiatives; Instigation and/or coordination of major learning and teaching projects, e.g. at the programme or faculty, level; Creation and maintenance of learning and teaching collaborations and communities of practice; Mentoring and development of other university teachers; and Public dissemination of effective and innovative teaching practice, e.g. via research publication, conference presentations, published reports, social media.
