We provide

- A structured teaching programme to guide your study and maintain a steady pace leading up to the exam

Dates and times

The course runs from 4 June 2026 to 28 January 2027. During this period, teaching sessions are held every Thursday afternoon from 2–4pm (NZ time).

Lecture recordings are uploaded to the teaching website weekly and remain available until the Divisional Clinical Examination in 2027.

Live lectures via Zoom, with recordings available for flexible, on-demand viewing.
