

# Regional Rural Admission Scheme (RRAS)

## Confirmation of Eligibility

### Guidelines for School Letter Submissions

There are places allocated for students of regional or rural origin in our undergraduate programmes in Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery, Bachelor of Optometry, Bachelor of Medical Imaging (Hons) and the Bachelor of Pharmacy. These places ensure equitable access for such students.

Students wishing to apply for one or more of these programmes under the Regional Rural Admissions Scheme (RRAS) category must provide the Faculty Student Centre with an official letter from the regional/rural school(s) they attended.

The letter must include **all** of the following:

- (a) The full legal name and date of birth of the applicant
- (b) The dates and duration of the applicant's study, e.g. "31 January 2017 to 31 November 2021 (Yr9 - 13)"
- (c) The name and physical location of the education institute

The letter should be **signed by the principal** or nominee, and **emailed** by the regional/rural education institution to:
