

Guidelines for school letter submissions

There are places allocated for students of regional or rural origin in our undergraduate programmes in Bachelor of Medical Imaging (Hons), Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery, Bachelor of Optometry, and the Bachelor of Pharmacy. These places ensure equitable access for such students.

Students wishing to apply for one or more of these programmes under the Regional Rural Admissions Scheme (RRAS) category must provide FMHS Admissions with an official letter from the regional/rural school(s) they attended.

The letter must include all of the following:

- 1. The full legal name and date of birth of the applicant
- 2. The dates and duration of the applicant's study, e.g. "31 January 2019 to 31 November 2023 (Yr9 13)"
- 3. The name and physical location of the education institute

The letter should be signed by the principal or nominee, and emailed by the regional/rural education institution to: FMHSadmission@auckland.ac.nz

Application closing dates
