# SAFE WORK INSTRUCTION

**AUTOMOTIVE PARTS WASHER** 

#### PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT



Safety glasses must be worn at all times.



Safety footwear must be worn.



Rings and jewellery must not be worn.



Protective gloves must be worn.



Close fitting / protective clothing must be worn.

## **POTENTIAL RISKS**

- ① Degreasing fluid and vapours.
- (i) Sharp edges and burrs.
- (i) Manual handling.
- i Fire.

## DON'Ts

- Do not use faulty equipment. Immediately report suspect machinery to your supervisor.
- Do not carry out any hot work (such as welding, grinding or using open flames) in the same area.
- Do not leave the washer running unattended.

## PRE-OPERATIONAL SAFETY CHECKS

- Locate and ensure you are familiar with all machine operations and controls.
- Consult the Safety Data Sheets (SDS) for specific safety information concerning the degreasing fluid used with this equipment.
- Ensure adequate ventilation.
- Check workspaces and walkways to ensure no slip/trip hazards are present.

### OPERATIONAL SAFETY CHECKS

- Be aware of other people in the area. Ensure the area is clear before starting the washer.
- Be careful not to splash or spread degreasing fluid outside the washer.

## ENDING OPERATIONS AND CLEANING UP

- Switch off the washer when work completed.
- ✓ Ensure lid is closed when work completed.
- Wash hands with soap and water after every use.
- Clean up spills immediately. Do not leave dirty rags/parts/tools lying around.
- Leave the work area in a safe, clean and tidy state.
