- Ensure the machine is serviceable, and that there is sufficient printing media for the task.

OPERATIONAL SAFETY CHECKS

- Keep clear of moving machine parts.
- Ensure the emergency stop switch is activated if there are any malfunctions.

ENDING OPERATIONS AND CLEANING UP

- Switch off the machine when work completed.
- Leave the machine and work area in a safe, clean and tidy state.
- Ensure the machine is disconnected from the wall if maintenance is to be carried out.
