- (i) This conjoint plan can be completed in five and a half years, though it involves a heavier-than-normal workload in four of those years. Students may choose to take a lighter load and extend their study period.
 (ii) In Years 2 and 3, the order of LAW 201–241 courses can be adjusted. The diagram shows one possible arrangement.
 (iii) Students planning a 60- or 120-point Law Exchange in their final year may need to rearrange their degree structure and consider Summer School enrolment.

* Course may include non-law courses such as General Education, Academic English Language Requirement (AELR), or Waipapa Taumata Rau (WTR) courses.
 **Although LAW 458 is an LLB elective, it is required by the Council for Legal Education (CLE) for students intending to be admitted to the Bar.
 *** Other conjoint courses may be taken in any of Years 2–6, including Summer School.

Requirements for LLB conjoint degrees combination (excluding BHSc/LLB), Total: 675 points

- 255 points as listed in the other bachelors component in the Conjoint Component Requirements Schedule
- 405 points as listed in the LLB component in the Conjoint Component Requirements Schedule
- 15 points from courses listed in either the General Education Open Schedule or either of the General Education Faculty Schedules approved for this conjoint degrees combination
- The University of Auckland Academic Integrity Course as specified in the Enrolment and Programme Regulations, Academic Integrity, of the University Calendar.

Requirements for BHSc/LLB: 270 points. General Education is not required.
