Intensive courses

The intensive courses are taught in a concentrated format.

These may fall outside normal semester dates and should be considered when planning any travel.

Course start date & material availability: Available on CANVAS one month before lectures start

Lecture dates: Varies. Please check timetable and SSO
Lecture hours: 8 hours per day. Please check timetable and SSO

Lecture duration for intensive courses:

•15 pt courses: 3 days

•30 pt courses: 5 days (usually incorporating a weekend break)

Final assessment intensive courses: Due 8-10 weeks after lectures end

Full-Semester courses

Course start date & material availability: Start of the semester

Lecture dates: Begins week one of each semester

Lecture hours: 3 hours per week in the early evening (e.g., 5-8 pm) **Lecture duration:** 12 weeks

Final assessment: Due at the end of semester lectures
