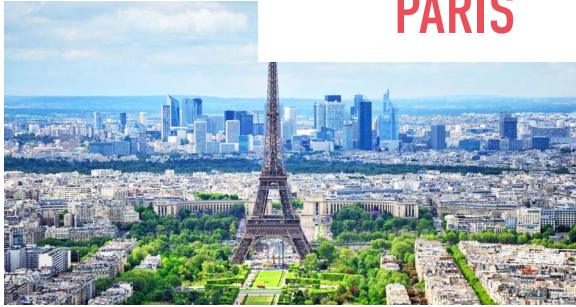
CASABLANCA

EXCHANGE PROGRAMS

BACHELOR LEVEL

Students can join the TBS Bachelor in Management Program if they have completed at least 1 year of Undergraduate study.

STUDY PERIODS for 2nd & 3rd year of Bachelor in Management :

- Fall or Spring semester only
- Full year
- Double Degree* (only available for B3)

NEW INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS MANAGEMENT SEMESTER (Fall only)

This semester includes 6 courses each worth 5 ECTS and is aimed at Bachelor 3rd and 4th Year students. Master 1 students can also apply if they cannot validate the credits from the traditional Master 1 courses offered.

MASTER LEVEL

Students can join the TBS Master in Management Year 1 if they have completed 3 years of Undergraduate study. Students can join the Msc Programs in the Master 2 year, if they have completed at least 1 year of Master Program.

STUDY PERIODS for 1st & 2nd year of Master in Management :

- Fall semester only
- Spring semester only (not available for M2)
- Full year
- Double Degree* (only available for M2)

*If TBS has signed a Double Degree Agreement

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

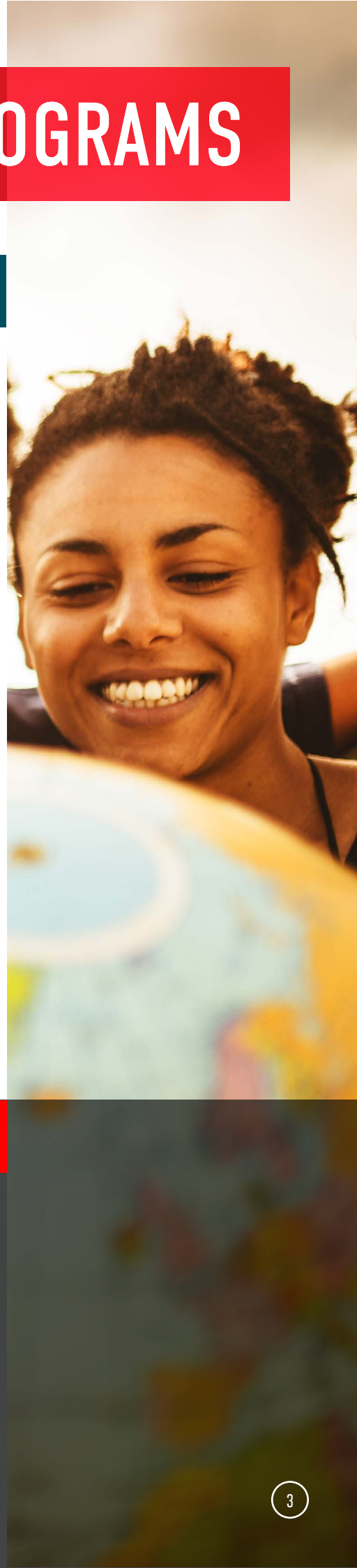
To study in English a B2 level required. Students can provide one of the following:

- Certificate from university language professor
- Cambridge First, Advanced and Proficiency
- TOEFL 79 (TOEFL at Home accepted)
- IELTS 6
- Duolingo 100

To study in French a B2 level required. Students can provide one of the following:

- Certificate from university language professor
- DELF B2

BACHELOR IN MANAGEMENT

COURSES AVAILABLE FOR BACHELOR YEAR 2 & YEAR 3 STUDENTS

YEAR 2

Bachelor in Management Year 2 students need to take modules on a variety of Business courses (the list of courses available will vary based on the semester intake, the campus or the track (English or French)). To validate their Semester, students need to take modules adding to a **minimum of 24 ECTS**. French language courses in Toulouse and Spanish language courses can also be taken.

For the fall intake in Toulouse, students can take the «Understanding French Culture and Business Practices» module which is offered as a pre-semester module. For the spring intake in Toulouse, students can also take a Cross Functional Skill (for 10 ECTS).

YEAR 3

To validate their Semester, students need to take modules adding to a **minimum of 24 ECTS**.

For the Fall intake, Bachelor in Management Year 3 is divided into two sections: students must choose a Specialization Paths (for 15 ECTS) and a Cross Functional Skill (for 10 ECTS). Students can also take language courses (for 5 ECTS) or the «Understanding French Culture and Business Practices» which is offered as a pre-semester module (for 5 ECTS).

For the Spring intake, Bachelor in Management Year 3 students can take modules from our B3 Specialization Paths (for 20 ECTS) or Cross-Cultural Communication courses (for 5 ECTS). Students can also take language courses (for 5 ECTS) or courses from the International Electives module (for 5 ECTS).

COURSES AVAILABLE FOR MASTER YEAR 1 & YEAR 2 STUDENTS



YEAR 1

Master in Management Year 1 students need to pick modules on a variety of Business courses (the list of courses available will vary based on the semester intake, the campus or the track (English or French)). To validate their Semester, students need to take modules adding to a **minimum of 24 ECTS**. French language courses in Toulouse and Spanish language courses can also be taken.

YEAR 2

Master in Management Year 2 is available for exchange students in the fall semester only or in the framework of a Double Degree (see information on Double Degree below). Fall semester only students need to take modules adding to a **minimum of 24 ECTS**. Students need to pick a specialization from our Master of Science Programs (28 ECTS). They can also take the Soft Skills module (6 ECTS), French language courses in Toulouse (5ECTS) or Spanish language courses in Barcelona (5ECTS).

YEAR 2 - DOUBLE DEGREE

Master Double Degree students need to choose a specialization from our Master of Science Programs (Msc). The TBS Msc Programs offer five complementary learning modules (including a 6 months internship) which are all compulsory. Students can also take French language courses in Toulouse or Spanish languages courses in Barcelona.

TIMETABLES

Timetables at TBS Education are only available digitally on the student's Outlook calendars. After nomination, students receive their TBS credentials, including an email address to connect on Outlook.

Depending on the chosen modules or specialization, timetables can vary. They are planned and synchronized by the TBS Back Office once courses times and rooms have been confirmed by professors. Students will be able to see their planned courses at least a week before they start.

ATTENDANCE

Attendance at TBS is taken by badging at the beginning of a class. To do so, students need to use their student ID card (which is also mandatory to access our campus). Student ID cards are only issued to students if they have completed their **Final Enrollment File** (online file). Around one month before their semester start, students will be contacted by the International Student Office about their file (with explanations on how to complete it). Students are expected to attend classes until the final day of each semester.

ACADEMIC CALENDARS

The Fall Semester at TBS starts in September and ends in December. A week holiday is usually planned at the end of October. The Spring Semester at TBS starts in January and ends in April. A holiday off is usually planned in February. [Click here](#) to find the current year's academic calendar.

SHORT PROGRAMS

SUMMER SCHOOL

The TBS Summer School takes place in Toulouse and Barcelona and runs for 6 weeks. A 3-week single track is also offered. Students can join the Summer School and earn up to 24 ECTS that can be transferred towards their degree.
