Other Information

Course availability

Only a select offer of MA-level courses is open to exchange students in semester 1. There are no MA-level courses available in semester 2. It is not possible to write a thesis and/or participate in a research project during the exchange.

Grading information

Students are graded on a <u>1-10 scale</u>. A full-time study load at Utrecht University equals 60 ECTS, or 30 ECTS per semester. Students are expected to take two 7.5 EC courses each period, or four courses each semester.
