

# Semester Exchange Programme

360 International offers you the opportunity to complete part of your University of Auckland degree overseas. You will have access to more than 130 renowned overseas partner universities where you will be able to attend classes for one or two semesters while earning credit towards your University of Auckland degree. Tuition fees remain the same while you are overseas and we have scholarship funds available to support many of our applicants.

# **Step 1** | Review our website and check eligibility

Visit our website at auckland.ac.nz/360 to see a detailed overview of How to Apply and check your eligibility as well as the best time to go on exchange for your degree programme.

# **Step 2** | Complete an Academic Planning Worksheet

Check your degree planner and programme requirements on Student Services Online to assess the best time to go on exchange and complete your Academic Planning Worksheet. Aim to save more flexible spaces in your degree planner to take while on exchanges, e.g. electives and other non-specified courses.

# **Step 3** | Complete the Host University Preferences & Proposed Courses Form

Explore the Partner University Fact Sheets and programme pages in the learning abroad portal at go.360international.ac.nz to identify a list of 5 potential host universities to list in order of preference on your application. It is important to take into account your personal preferences, course availability, cost of living, and funding available when considering your options.

# **Step 4** | Submit an Application for Exchange

When ready to apply, you will begin an application in the learning abroad portal at go.360international.ac.nz, starting from the appropriate term for your first choice partner university. You will need to upload your supporting documents and at the end you will be asked to list up to 4 alternate universities that you would be interested in attending if we are unable to place you at your first choice.

#### **Deadlines**

Apply by 1 July for Semester One Exchanges\* Apply by 1 December for Semester Two Exchanges

\*Be aware that some universities only have one annual deadline, requiring that you apply 2 terms in advance.

# Step 5 | Receive a Nomination Offer

Eligible applicants will receive a nomination offer from the 360 International team approximately 6-8 weeks after the application deadline. Nomination offers will be for a single partner university and allow you to proceed with applying to that university under our bilateral exchange agreement.

# Step 6 | Apply to the Host University

Following instructions from 360 International, you will apply to your designated host university by their respective application deadlines.

# **Step 7** | Receive Faculty Course Approvals

Once you have received a nomination offer, you will work with your Faculty to obtain course approvals for the courses you intend to take while on exchange. Flexibility is important, and having sufficient alternates you can take on exchange is advised.

# **Step 8** | Complete Pre-Departure Requirements

The 360 International team will guide you through the pre-departure process leading up to the exchange, providing guidance at each step of the way, from enrolments, to StudyLink, to culture shock and wellbeing.
