America/ Asia (Unless otherwise noted) (Standard Full-Time Course Load = 15-16 Credits)

Total Credit Load Requirements

- 12 credits = 45 UoA points
- 15-16 credits = 60 UoA points (Standard Full Time Courseload)
- 18 credits = 75 UoA points

Further Information

- 3 credit courses must be taken in sets of 5:4 for 60 points credit to be brought back
- 4 credit courses = 15 UoA points which is equivalent to one UoA course. You can use the 1:1 Study Plan Template

Note

- Business students may be required to select from designated courses for the 5th course in a 5:4 set.
- All other disciplines (excluding Law) may add a course of their choice to make up the required courseload based on how many points they wish to transfer back.
- All courses on exchange must be passed to bring full credit back.

Japanese Partner Institutions (Standard Full-Time Course Load = 16 Credits)

Total Credit Load Requirements

- 12 credits = 45 UoA points
- 16 credits = 60 UoA points (Standard Full Time Courseload)
- 18 credits = 75 UoA points
- You need to take 7 courses to be eligible for General Education Exemption

Further Information

- 4 credits = 15 UoA points
- Courses must generally be taken in pairs of 2 x 2 credits = 15 UoA points.

University of Toronto (Standard Full-Time Course Load = 2.5 Credits)

Total Credit Load Requirements

- 2 credits = 45 UoA points (General Education Exemption eligible)
- 2.5 credits = 60 UoA points (Standard Full Time Courseload)
- 3 credits = 75 UoA points

Europe/ ECTS (Standard Full-Time Course Load = 28-30 ECTS)

Total Credit Load Requirements

- 24 ECTS = 45 UoA points
- 30 ECTS = 60 UoA points (Standard Full Time Courseload)

Further Information

- 1 ECTS = 2 UoA Points
- 7.5 ECTS = 15 UoA Points
- 3-4 ECTS courses must typically be paired in sets that add up to 15 ECTS (5 x 3 ECTS = 15 ECTS = 30 UoA points)
- 5 ECTS courses must typically be taken in sets of 3:4 (6 x 5 ECTS = 4 x 15 UoA points = 60 UoA points)
- 6 ECTS courses must typically be taken in sets of 5:4 (5 x 6 ECTS = 4 x 15 UoA points = 60 UoA points)
- 7.5 ECTS courses may be credited back on a 1:1 ratio for 15 UoA points each
- 10 ECTS courses may be taken in sets of 3:4, with an optional 15 points top-up credit available to credit back

Dartmouth College (Standard Full-Time Course Load = 4 Credits)

Total Credit Load Requirements

- 3 credits (3 Courses) = 45 UoA points
- 4 credits (4 Courses) = 60 UoA points (only available where special 4th course is added in the Fall semester as General Education)

• 1 credit = 15 UoA points

UK/ University of Nottingham at Ningbo (Standard Full-Time Course Load = 60 credits)

Total Credit Load Requirements

- 50 credits = 45-50 UoA points
- 60 credits = 60 UoA points (Standard Full Time Courseload)

Further Information

- 15 credits = 15 UoA points
- 10 UK credit courses must be taken in sets of 3:2 (3 x 10 UK credits = 2 x 15 UoA points = 30 UoA points)
- 20 UK credit courses may be taken in sets of 3:4, with an optional 15 points top-up credit available to credit back
- Overloading is generally not permitted. Students studying in the UK should not expect to bring back 75 points.

CUHK - Master of Architecture (only)

- 12-13 credits = 60 UoA points (Standard Full Time Courseload)
- 3 Credits = 15 UoA points

University of Hong Kong

- 30 ECTS = 60 UoA points (Standard Full Time Courseload)
- 24 ECTS = 45 UoA points
