Top-up credit awarded may change depending on your final combination of courses enrolled at the host university and is typically unspecified credit in the primary subject area of the other three courses passed and lowest common denominator for level. **Top-up credit is typically best used towards the General Education Exemption and/or an out-of-schedule Elective space in the degree planner.**
