Young Woman's Study Award up to \$1,000

An award of up to \$1,000 is offered to a young woman aged 16 - 25 to further her education or training.

Purpose: To assist in financing a female student's first post-secondary school course, leading to a professional or vocational qualification. This award is primarily targeted at a student aiming to complete a vocational or trade qualification, but applicants aiming for university study will also be considered.

Eligibility Criteria: Applicants must:

- ❖ be a female student under the age d 16 25 (at closing date for applications)
- be a New Zealand resident
- ❖ live in the area bounded by the Tamaki Estuary in the north, the western coast from Port Waikato up to Manukau Harbour and Pokeno in the South, excluding the area east of the Southern Motorway and north of a line from Redoubt Road to its corner with Mill Road and then directly to the coast at the Wairoa River estuary.
- demonstrate financial need.
- provide evidence of enrolment in or application for a post-secondary school course in 2026 at Level 3 or above.
- provide evidence of success in the student's most recent study.
- provide contact details for two referees one for an academic reference and one for a character reference.

Other Information on the Award:

Applicants will be evaluated on effort and determination to complete their objective, the value of the course to themselves and to the community, and their need for financial assistance.

The shortlisted applicants must be available for an on-line interview with the selection committee in the week of 15-19 September 2025

The Award presentation will be made at the Zonta South Auckland Awards Evening on Wednesday, 1 October 2025

The successful applicant will be expected to update Zonta South Auckland with her progress during the year at the October 2026 Awards Evening. This could be in person or via a short written report.
