Description

The fund for this Prize was established by those who graduated in law while Professor A G Davis was Dean of the Law School.

The A G Davis Prize in Law contributes to the support of a full-time University of Auckland Law student who has shown academic excellence.

Selection process

- Nomination is made to the Scholarships Office
- The Prize is awarded by the University of Auckland Council on the recommendation of the Dean of Law

Regulations

- 1. The Prize will be known as the A G Davis Prize in Law.
- 2. The value of the Prize will be \$500.
- 3. The Prize will be awarded annually to the full-time student enrolled in an LLB or LLB(Honours) degree who has achieved the highest GPA in Part II Law courses in the year of the award. As a minimum standard, the student should have achieved a GPA of at least 7.00. In the event of a tie, the Prize will be awarded to the student achieving the highest aggregate marks in Part II Law courses (see Note I).
- 4. The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council on the recommendation of the Dean of the Faculty of Law.
- 5. The Prize may not be shared.
- 6. The University of Auckland Council has the power to amend or vary these Regulations provided that there is no departure from the main purpose of the Prize.
- 7. Note [I] below is deemed to be a Regulation.
