Description

These awards, previously known as the Amalgamated Brick Prizes, were established in 1927.

Selection process

- Nomination is made to the Scholarships Office
- The Prize will be awarded to the student whose designs are selected by a panel appointed by the Head of the School of Architecture and Planning

Regulations

- 1. The Prize will be known as the Auckland Brick Manufacturers' Prize.
- 2. The value of the Prize will be \$500.
- The Prize will be awarded annually to a student enrolled in Part I of the Degree of Master of Architecture (Professional) (MArch(Prof)) achieving the most meritorious design project in Advanced Design 1 or 2 (ARCHDES 700 and 701).
- 4. The Prize will be awarded to the student whose designs are selected by a panel appointed by the Head of the School of Architecture and Planning.
- 5. The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council on the recommendation of the Head of School of Architecture and Planning.
- 6. The University of Auckland Council will not be bound to award the Prize in any year if there is no candidate of sufficient merit.
- 7. In the event of a tie, the Head of the School of Architecture and Planning shall determine if the Prize may be shared.
- 8. The University of Auckland Council has the power to amend or vary these regulations provided that there is no departure from the main purpose of the Prize.
