## Description

---

The Prize was established in 1997 and is financed from funds donated by Ms Camille Rosenfeldt of Auckland in memory of her parents.

The main purpose of the Prize is to encourage students studying and performing Chamber Music at The University of Auckland.

## Selection process

---

- Nomination is made to the Scholarships Office
- The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council upon the recommendation of the Head of the School of Music

## Regulations

---

1. The Prize will be known as the Carl and Alberta Rosenfeldt Prize in Chamber Music.
2. The value of the Prize will be \$1,200 to be shared equally between all the members of the successful group(s).
3. The Prize will be awarded annually to the most outstanding chamber music group(s), the members of which are enrolled in the subject Chamber Music.
4. The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council upon the recommendation of the Head of the School of Music following the Chamber Music Assessments in semester two.
5. The University of Auckland Council will not be bound to award the Prize in any year if there are no candidates of sufficient merit.
6. In the event of a tie, the Head of the School of Music shall determine if the Prize may be shared.
7. The University of Auckland Council has the power to amend or vary these regulations on the recommendation of the Head of the School of Music provided that there is no departure from the main purpose of the Prize.
