Description

The CPA Australia Prize was established in 2008 by CPA Australia.

The main purpose of the Prize is to recognise overall outstanding achievement in Accounting by a third year BCom or BBIM student.

Selection process

- Nomination is made to the Scholarships Office
- The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council upon the recommendation of the Head of the Department of Accounting and Finance

Regulations

- 1. The Prize will be known as the CPA Australia Prize.
- 2. The value of the Prize will be \$1,000.
- The Prize will be awarded annually to the full-time student achieving the highest average mark in a minimum of four 300-level courses in Accounting.
- 4. The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council upon the recommendation of the Head of the Department of Accounting and Finance.
- 5. In the event of a tie, the Head of the Department of Accounting and Finance shall determine, in consultation with CPA Australia, if the Prize may be shared.
- 6. The University of Auckland Council has the power to amend or vary these regulations provided that there is no departure from the main purpose of the Prize.
