## Description

This Prize was established in 1991 by the Auckland Branch of Engineers for Social Responsibility to increase the awareness and interest of engineering students in the social aspects of their programme.

## Selection process

---

- Nomination will be made to the Scholarships Office
- The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council on the recommendation of the Dean of Engineering

## Regulations

---

1. The Prize will be known as the ESR Prize.
2. The Prize will consist of a book selected by the Auckland Committee of Engineers for Social Responsibility and two years' free membership of ESR.
3. The Prize will be awarded each year to the student who attains the highest overall mark in the course ENGGEN 403.
4. The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council on the recommendation of the Dean of Engineering (or nominee).
5. In the event of a tie, the Dean of Engineering (or nominee) shall determine if the Prize may be shared.
6. The University of Auckland Council has the power to amend or vary these regulations provided that there is no departure from the main purpose of the Prize.
