Description

This Prize was established in 1985 by Professor R S Marsel in memory of the late Professor Geoffrey F Powell, DSO, MA, a visiting member of the Faculty of Law in 1972 and 1973.

Selection process

- Nomination is made to the Scholarships Office
- The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council upon the recommendation of the Dean of the Faculty of Law

Regulations

- 1. The Prize will be known as the Geoffrey Powell Prize.
- 2. The value of the Prize will be \$500.
- 3. The Prize will be awarded annually to the participant adjudged best mooter in the final of the Stout Shield Mooting Competition.
- 4. The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council upon the recommendation of the Dean of the Faculty of Law
- 5. The University of Auckland Council will not be bound to award the Prize if in any year there is no candidate of sufficient merit.
- 6. In the event of a tie, the Dean of the Faculty of Law will determine if the Prize may be shared.
- 7. The University of Auckland Council has the power to amend or vary these regulations provided that there is no departure from the main purpose of the Prize.
