Description

This Prize was established in 1985 by Professor R S Marsel in memory of the late Professor Geoffrey F Powell, DSO, MA, a visiting member of the Faculty of Law in 1972 and 1973.

Selection process

- Nomination is made to the Scholarships Office
- The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council upon the recommendation of the Dean of the Faculty of Law (or nominee)

Regulations

- 1. The Prize will be known as the Geoffrey Powell Prize.
- 2. One Prize will be awarded annually and will be of the value of \$500.
- The Prize will be awarded annually to the participant adjudged best mooter in the final of the Stout Shield Mooting Competition in the Faculty of Law.
- 4. The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council on the recommendation of the Dean of the Faculty of Law (or nominee).
- 5. The Prize may not be shared.
- 6. The University of Auckland Council is not obliged to make an award if it is determined there is no candidate that meets the criteria and/or no candidate of sufficient merit.
- 7. The University of Auckland Council can amend or vary these regulations provided that there is no departure from the main purpose of the Prize.
