Description

The Prize was established in 1996 and is funded by the Department of Psychiatry.

Selection process

- Nomination is made to the Scholarships Office
- The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council on the recommendation of the Head of the Department of Psychological Medicine

Regulations

- 1. The Prize will be known as the J S Werry Prize in Psychiatry.
- 2. The value of the Prize will be \$500.
- 3. The Prize will be awarded annually to the student who secures the highest overall marks in the Psychiatry attachment of the MBChB.
- 4. The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council on the recommendation of the Head of the Department of Psychological Medicine.
- 5. The University of Auckland Council will not be bound to award the Prize in any year if there is no candidate of sufficient merit.
- 6. In the event of a tie, the Head of the Department of Psychiatry will determine if the Prize may be shared.
- 7. The University of Auckland Council has the power to amend or vary these regulations provided that there is no departure from the main purpose of the Prize.
