Description

The KBB Music Jazz Woodwind Player of the Year Prize was established in 2013 by KBB Music. Established in 1888, KBB Music is a leading musical instrument specialist in the New Zealand market.

The main purpose of the Prize is to assist and encourage excellence in a promising undergraduate student majoring in Jazz Performance on a woodwind instrument.

Selection process

- Nomination is made to the Scholarships Office
- The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council upon the recommendation of the Head of School of Music

Regulations

- 1. The Prize will be known as the KBB Music Jazz Woodwind Player of the Year Prize.
- 2. The value of the Prize will be a \$500 KBB Music Voucher.
- 3. The Prize will be awarded annually to the full-time student majoring in Jazz Performance who has achieved the highest mark in MUS 371 Jazz Performance 6 on a woodwind instrument. As a minimum standard the student should have achieved at least an A- grade. In the event of a tie, the Prize will be awarded to the student who achieved the highest mark for their public recital.
- 4. The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council upon the recommendation of the Head of School of Music (or nominee).
- 5. The University of Auckland Council will not be bound to award the Prize in any year if there is no candidate of sufficient merit.
- 6. The Prize may not be shared.
- 7. The University of Auckland Council has the power to amend or vary these regulations provided that there is no departure from the main purpose of the Prize.
