Description

The Prize was established by subscription from past and present students and associates, as a tribute to Professor K B Cumberland on his retirement in 1978 after holding the foundation Chair in Geography since 1949.

Selection process

- Nomination is made to the Scholarships Office
- The Prize is awarded by the University of Auckland Council on the recommendation of the Head of the School of Environment

Regulations

- 1. The Prize will be known as the Kenneth B Cumberland Prize in Geography.
- 2. The value of the Prize will be \$600.
- 3. The Prize will be awarded for the best thesis in the year preceding the award by a masters student in Geography.
- 4. The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council upon the recommendation of the Head of the School of Environment.
- 5. The University of Auckland Council will not be bound to award the Prize in any year if there is no candidate of sufficient merit.
- 6. In the event of a tie, the Head of the School of Environment shall determine if the Prize may be shared.
- 7. The University of Auckland Council has the power to amend or vary these regulations provided that there is no departure from the main purpose of the Prize.
