Description

The Prize was established in 1991 by the Leukaemia and Blood Foundation. This was renamed the Leukaemia and Blood Cancer Prize in 2015.

Selection process

- Nomination is made to the Scholarships Office
- The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council on the recommendation of the Head of the Department of Molecular Medicine and Pathology

Regulations

- 1. The Prize will be known as the Leukaemia and Blood Cancer Prize.
- 2. The value of the Prize will be \$500.
- 3. The Prize will be awarded annually to the student who achieved the highest marks in the Blood, Immunity and Infection module of the MBChB 321 course. In the event of a tie, the Prize will be awarded to the student who achieved the highest mark in the oral examination.
- The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council on the recommendation of the Head of the Department of Molecular Medicine and Pathology.
- 5. The University of Auckland Council will not be bound to award the Prize in any year if there is no candidate of sufficient merit.
- 6. The Prize may not be shared.
- 7. The University of Auckland Council has the power to amend or vary these regulations provided that there is no departure from the main purpose of the Prize.
