Description

The Prize was established in honour and memory of Associate-Professor E M A Bullivant and to encourage research in physiology.

Selection process

- Nomination is made to the Scholarships Office
- The Prize will be awarded annually by the University of Auckland Council on the recommendation of the Head of the Department of Physiology

Regulations

- 1. The Prize will be known as the Mary Bullivant Prize in Physiology.
- 2. One Prize will be awarded annually and will be of the value of \$500.
- 3. The Prize will be awarded for distinction in postgraduate studies undertaken by a student in the Department of Physiology (see Note I).
- 4. The Prize will be awarded annually by the University of Auckland Council on the recommendation of the Head of the Department of Physiology.
- 5. The University of Auckland Council will not be bound to award the Prize in any year if there is no candidate of sufficient merit.
- 6. The Prize may not be shared.
- 7. The University of Auckland Council has the power to amend or vary these regulations provided that there is no departure from the main purpose of the Prize.
- 8. Note [I] below is deemed to be a regulation.

Notes

I. This will be determined by factors such as the academic grade achieved and other scholarly successes including, but not limited to, winning a prize for a conference presentation, selection to give a conference presentation, research

contributions sufficient to be named as author on the research paper.
