Description

The Prize was established in 2005 by the New Zealand Society of Notaries Incorporated to encourage excellence in the subject Conflict of Laws.

Selection process

- Nomination is made to the Scholarships Office
- The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council upon the recommendation of the Dean of the Faculty of Law

Regulations

- 1. The Prize will be known as the New Zealand Society of Notaries Incorporated Conflict of Laws Prize.
- 2. The value of the Prize will be \$1,000.
- 3. The Prize will be awarded annually to the student achieving the highest marks in the course LAWCOMM 413 Conflict of Laws or an equivalent course. As a minimum standard, the student should have achieved at least an A- grade.
- 4. The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council upon the recommendation of the Dean of the Faculty of Law (or nominee).
- 5. In the event of a tie, the Dean of Law shall determine if the Prize may be shared.
- 6. The University of Auckland Council is not obliged to make an award if it is determined there is no candidate that meets the criteria and/or no candidate of sufficient merit.
- 7. The University of Auckland Council can amend or vary these regulations provided that there is no variation from the main purpose of the Prize.
