Specific Terms of the Prize

1. Prize description

- (1) The objective of the prize is to recognise and encourage academic excellence in Applied Finance at Waipapa Taumata Rau, University of Auckland.
- (2) The terms of the prize comprise sections 5 to 23 of the [Scholarships and Prizes Statute 2025 \(Statute\)](#), these Specific Terms, and any requirements stated on the application form or stipulated in writing by the Director.

2. Prize value

The prize comprises \$1,500 paid in one instalment.

3. Eligibility criteria

- (1) The eligibility criteria for the prize are:
 - (a) the recipient(s) must have completed Part II of the Master of Applied Finance; and
 - (b) the recipient(s) must have achieved a GPA of at least 7.0 (equivalent to an A- average) across Part II of the Master of Applied Finance.

4. Selection process and criteria

- (1) The prize is granted by the Vice-Chancellor after receiving a recommendation or nomination from the Director of the Graduate School of Management (or nominee).
- (2) The Director of the Graduate School of Management (or nominee) will consult with the Director of the Master of Applied Finance programme (or nominee) before making a recommendation or nomination to the Vice-Chancellor.
- (3) The selection criteria for the grant of a prize are:
 - (a) the recipient(s) who achieved the highest GPA across Part II of the Master of Applied Finance.

- (4) In the event of a tie, the Director of the Graduate School of Management (or nominee), in consultation with the Director of the Master of Applied Finance programme (or nominee), will determine if the prize may be shared.

5. Definitions

- (1) A word that is defined in section 23 (Definitions) of the [Statute](#) has the same meaning when used in these Specific Terms.

6. Commencement

These Specific Terms come into force on 4 August 2026.
