Description

The Prize was established in 2004 and is funded by the New Zealand Architects Co-operative Society Ltd (NZACS).

The main purpose of the Prize is to reward excellence in the subject ARCHPRM 701 Practice Management.

Selection process

- Nomination will be made to the Scholarships Office.
- The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council upon the recommendation of the Head of the School of Architecture and Planning

Regulations

- 1. The Prize will be known as the NZACS Prize.
- 2. The Prize will be awarded annually and will be of the value of \$1,500.
- 3. The Prize will be awarded annually to the student achieving the best grade in ARCHPRM 701 Practice Management. As a minimum standard, the student must receive an A- grade. In the event of a tie, the Prize will be awarded to the student achieving the highest mark.
- 4. The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council on the recommendation of the Head of the School of Architecture and Planning (or nominee).
- 5. In the event of a tie, the Head of the School of Architecture and Planning (or nominee) will determine, if the Prize may
- 6. The University of Auckland Council is not obliged to make an award if it is determined there is no candidate that meets the criteria and/or no candidate of sufficient merit.
- 7. The University of Auckland Council can amend or vary these regulations, in consultation with the New Zealand Architects Co-operative Society Ltd., provided that there is no departure from the main purpose of the Prize.
