## Description

The Prize was established in 2011 and is funded by Prestidges, a family run New Zealand uniform designer, manufacturer and retailer with a reputation for producing high quality medical wear.

The main purpose of the Prize is to recognise the student who has demonstrated exceptional leadership qualities and peer support throughout the Bachelor of Nursing programme, as voted by the completing class.

## Selection process

- Nomination is made to the Scholarships Office
- The Prize is awarded by the University of Auckland Council on the recommendation of the Head of the School of Nursing (or nominee)

## Regulations

1. The Prize will be known as the Prestidges Prize.
2. One Prize will be made annually and will be of the value of \$500.
3. The Prize will be made to the final year Bachelor of Nursing student who has demonstrated exceptional leadership qualities and peer support throughout the Bachelor of Nursing programme, as voted by the completing class.
4. The Prize will be made by the University of Auckland Council on the recommendation of the Head of the School of Nursing (or nominee).
5. The University of Auckland Council is not obliged to make an award if it is determined there is no candidate that meets the criteria and/or no candidate of sufficient merit.
6. The Prize may not be shared.
7. The University of Auckland Council can amend or vary these regulations provided that there is no departure from the main purpose of the Prize.
