Description

The Prize was established in 2001 by the Auckland Faculty of the New Zealand College of General Practitioners.

Selection process

- Nomination will be made to the Scholarships Office
- The Prize shall be awarded by the University of Auckland Council on the recommendation of the Head of the Department of General Practice and Primary Health Care

Regulations

- 1. The Prize will be known as the Royal NZ College of General Practitioners 5th Year General Practice Prize.
- 2. The value of the Prize will be \$1,000.
- 3. The Prize will be awarded annually to the MBChB Part V student who achieves the highest overall marks in the General Practice component.
- 4. The Prize shall be awarded by the University of Auckland Council on the recommendation of the Head of the Department of General Practice and Primary Health Care.
- 5. The University of Auckland Council will not be bound to award the Prize in any year if there is no candidate of sufficient merit.
- 6. In the event of a tie, the Head of the Department of General Practice and Primary Health Care will determine if the Prize may be shared.
- 7. The University of Auckland Council has the power to amend or vary these regulations provided that there is no departure from the main purpose of the Prize.
