## **Description**

The Prize was established in 2007.

The main purpose of the Prize is to reward excellence in the Master of Urban Design degree programme.

## Selection process

- Nomination is made to the Scholarships Office
- The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council upon the recommendation of the Head of the School of Architecture and Planning

## Regulations

- 1. The Prize will be known as the Urbanism+ Award for Excellence in Urban Design.
- 2. The value of the Prize will be up to \$2,000. The Prize may be presented either to one student, or at least \$1,000 to the main recipient and the balance to one or two students who receive commendations.
- 3. The Prize will be awarded annually to the enrolled student who delivers outstanding work in the Master of Urban Design Programme. The winning project will be selected by a panel comprised of at least one representative from the School of Architecture and Planning and one representative from Urbanism+.
- 4. The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council upon the recommendation of the Head of the School of Architecture and Planning.
- 5. The University of Auckland Council will not be bound to award the Prize in any year if there is no candidate of sufficient merit.
- 6. In the event of a tie, the Head of the School of Architecture and Planning shall determine, in consultation with Urbanism+, if the Prize may be shared.
- 7. The University of Auckland Council has the power to amend or vary these regulations, with the consent of Urbanism+, provided that there is no departure from the main purpose of the Prize.
