## Description

The Prize was established in 2005 by the New Zealand Society of Notaries Incorporated to encourage excellence in the subject Conflict of Laws.

## Selection process

---

- Nomination is made to the Scholarships Office
- The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council upon the recommendation of the Dean of the Faculty of Law

## Regulations

---

1. The Prize will be known as the New Zealand Society of Notaries Incorporated Conflict of Laws Prize.
2. The value of the Prize will be \$1,000.
3. The Prize will be awarded annually to the student achieving the highest marks in the course LAWCOMM 413 Conflict of Laws or an equivalent course. As a minimum standard, the student should have achieved at least an A- grade.
4. The Prize will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council upon the recommendation of the Dean of the Faculty of Law (or nominee).
5. In the event of a tie, the Dean of Law shall determine if the Prize may be shared.
6. The University of Auckland Council is not obliged to make an award if it is determined there is no candidate that meets the criteria and/or no candidate of sufficient merit.
7. The University of Auckland Council can amend or vary these regulations provided that there is no variation from the main purpose of the Prize.
