Description

The Award was established to assist students in their second year of Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) studies.

Selection process

- Nomination is made to the Scholarships Office
- The Award is made by the University of Auckland Council on the recommendation of the Dean of the Faculty of Engineering

Regulations

- 1. The Award will be known as the Robert Horton Engineering Award.
- 2. The Award will have an annual value of \$1,400.
- 3. The Award will be made to the student enrolled in Part II of a Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (BE(Hons)) who achieved the highest GPA across all Part I courses. As a minimum standard, the student must have achieved a GPA of 7.00 (equivalent to an A- average).
- 4. The Award will be made by the University of Auckland Council upon the recommendation of the Dean of the Faculty of Engineering (or nominee).
- 5. In the event of a tie, the Dean of the Faculty of Engineering (or nominee) will determine whether the Award may be shared.
- 6. Payment of the Award will be made in Semester One of Part II of enrolment in the BE(Hons).
- 7. The University of Auckland Council is not obliged to make an award if in any year there are no candidates of sufficient merit.
- 8. The University of Auckland Council has the power to amend or vary these regulations provided that there is no departure from the main purpose of the Award.
