## Description

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The Prize was established in 2023 and is funded by Steel Rollformed Products Ltd, a New Zealand owned and operated family business the supplies quality steel components to the New Zealand building industry.

The main purpose of the Prize is to reward and recognise academic excellence in ARCHTECH 207 and ARCHTECH 210.

## Selection process

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- Nomination is made to the Scholarships Office
- The Prize is awarded by the University of Auckland Council on the recommendation of the Selection Committee

## Regulations

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1. The Prize will be known as the Steel Rollformed Products Ltd Prize.
2. Two Prizes will be awarded annually and will be of the value of \$1,000 each.
3. One Prize will be awarded to the student who achieved the highest mark in ARCHTECH 207 Design Technology 1, and one Prize will be awarded to the student who achieved the highest mark in ARCHTECH 210 Environmental Design 1. As a minimum standard, the students must have achieved an A- grade.
4. The Prizes will be awarded by the University of Auckland Council upon the recommendation of the Head of the School of Architecture and Planning (or nominee).
5. In the event of a tie, the Head of the School of Architecture and Planning will determine whether the Prizes may be shared.
6. The University of Auckland Council is not obliged to make an award if it is determined there is no candidate that meets the criteria and/or no candidate of sufficient merit.
7. The University of Auckland Council can amend or vary these regulations provided that there is no departure from the main purpose of the Prize.
