

# Waipapa Taumata Rau Demographics 2022

## Purpose

This document provides information about the diverse characteristics of students and staff at Waipapa Taumata Rau | The University of Auckland.

## Overview of 2022

For undergraduate and postgraduate students, the most commonly identified ethnicity is Asian, and the most commonly identified gender is female.

For academic and professional staff, the most commonly identified ethnicity is Pākēha/European, and the most commonly identified gender is female.

This overview is unchanged from 2021 as the demographic composition of our community is fairly stable.

## Key Trends for 2020 – 2022

Waipapa Taumata Rau is experiencing gradual shifts in the demographic composition of student and staff communities.

### Student Community

Shifts in the composition of the student community are mainly driven by undergraduate students. Since 2020 there have been steady increases in the percentage of students who identify themselves as:

- Asian
- Disabled
- LGBTQIATakatāpuiMVPFAFF+.

There has also been a steady decrease in the percentage of students who identify themselves as Pākehā/European.

The gender composition of the student community has remained stable since 2020. The percentages of students who are Māori, Pacific, have a constrained economic background or a refugee background have also remained stable since 2020.

### Staff Community

Since 2020 there have been increases in the percentages of staff who identify themselves as:

- Māori, Pacific, or Asian, particularly amongst professional staff
- Female, particularly amongst academic staff
- Disabled
- LGBTQIATakatāpuiMVPFAFF+.

There have also been decreases in the percentages of staff who identify themselves as:

- Pākēha/European, particularly amongst professional staff
- Male, particularly amongst academic staff.

Despite these shifts, senior academic and professional staff predominantly identify themselves as Pākēha/European, and senior academic staff predominantly identify themselves as male.

This report provides insight into our community with measurement classes and levels of reporting.

## Measurement classes:

1. Ethnicity
2. Gender
3. Disability
4. Refugee background
5. LGBTQIATakatāpuiMVPFAFF+ Rainbow
6. Constrained Economic Background (CEB).

## Levels of reporting

Data in each class are reported at three levels:

1. University community
2. Student community
3. Staff community.

An exception to the levels of reporting is CEB, which is only reported at the student community level.

## Data Presentation

Census data are presented for all measures, reflecting the number of people in each group.

Some people are both students and staff and will be counted twice.

Some people identify as belonging to more than one measurement class, and will be counted in each of them.

In general, data are accurate as of 9 April 2023. Student Community Qualification Completions and Academic Staff by Role data are accurate as of 26 April 2023.

The acronym LGBTQIATakatāpuiMVPFAFF+, and the term Rainbow, are used for lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, intersex and asexual – with:

- Takatāpui being a term embracing all Māori with diverse genders, sexualities, and sex characteristics.
- MVPFAFF embracing Pacific identities
  - Mahu – Hawai’i and Tahiti
  - Vaka sa lewa – Fiji
  - Palopa – Papua New Guinea
  - Fa’afafine – Samoa
  - Akava’ine – Rarotonga
  - Fakaleiti – Tonga
  - Fakafifine – Niue.

Other key terms and their abbreviations are set out on the final page of this document.

Chart 1.1A Student Community 2020-2022




Chart 1.1B Staff Community 2020-2022



Chart 1.2A Undergraduate Student Community 2020-2022





Chart 1.2B Taught Postgraduate Student Community 2020-2022

Chart 1.2C Research Postgraduate Student Community 2020-2022



Chart 1.5A Academic Staff 2020-2022





Chart 1.5B Professional Staff 2020-2022

Chart 2.1A Student Community by Gender 2020-2022




Chart 2.1B Staff Community by Gender 2020-2022




Chart 2.1C Student Community Characteristics 2020-2022




Chart 2.1D Staff Community Characteristics 2020-2022



Chart 2.2A Undergraduate Student Community by Gender 2020-2022






Chart 2.2B Taught Postgraduate Student Community by Gender 2020-2022




Chart 2.2C Research Postgraduate Student Community by Gender 2020-2022

**Chart 2.2F Research Postgraduate Student Community Characteristics 2020-2022**



Chart 2.5A Academic Staff by Gender 2020-2022




Chart 2.5B Professional Staff by Gender 2020-2022




Chart 2.5C Academic Staff Characteristics 2020-2022




Chart 2.5D Professional Staff Characteristics 2020-2022


