Bachelor of Arts Programme Regulations:

1. Courses in a minimum of three subjects listed in the BA Schedule.
2. At least 180 points (12 courses) must be above Stage I.
3. Up to 30 points (2 courses) may be taken from outside the Faculty.
4. 30 points (2 courses) must be taken from the appropriate General Education Schedules for BA students.
5. At least 75 points (5 courses) must be at Stage III.
6. Major must include at least 60 points (4 courses) at Stage III.
7. Minor must include at least 60 points (4 courses) above Stage I.

The advice given in this planner is based on the assumption that a pass grade is achieved for all current enrolments. If you add, drop or swap courses, the advice provided in this planner may no longer reflect your remaining requirements. If you decide to change your enrolments, we recommend that you request a new planner. It is the student's responsibility to check that the final programme complies with University Regulations. The Faculty of Arts is the final authority on all BA regulations.
