### Bachelor of Science Programme Regulations:

1. At least 150 points (10 courses) must be above Stage I.
2. At least 75 points (5 courses) must be at Stage III.
3. A major must include 60 points (4 courses) at Stage III; if completing a double major the first major must include 60 points at Stage III and the second major must include 45 points (3 courses) at Stage III.

- 15 points must be a [General Education](#) course from either the Arts, Science or Open schedule.
- A further 15 point may be taken from any General Education schedule or any course available at the University

### Bachelor of Global Studies Programme Regulations:

1. At least 165 points (11 courses) must be above Stage I.
2. At least 75 points (5 courses) must be at Stage III.
3. Major must include at least 45 points (3 courses) at Stage III.
4. At least 30 points (2 courses) of language study must be above Stage I.
5. At least 15 points (1 course) of Area Studies must be at Stage III.

The advice given in this planner is based on the assumption that a pass grade is achieved for all current enrolments. If you add, drop or swap courses, the advice provided in this planner may no longer reflect your remaining requirements. If you decide to change your enrolments, we recommend that you request a new planner. It is the student's responsibility to check that the final programme complies with University Regulations. The Faculty of Arts is the final authority on all BGlobalSt regulations.
