The programme is interdisciplinary in approach and addresses challenges that managers face as they seek to maintain and grow organisations in a dynamic context. It is designed around three major themes:

The MBA aims to expand participants' knowledge and experience of leadership and managing business growth in a local and international context.

There are two intakes per year for this programme, enabling students to grow their network as new participants join the programme.

Is this programme for me?

The MBA programme has been designed to enable practising managers to study part-time, with courses delivered in weekend blocks.

Courses are taught using an interactive and experientially-based pedagogy with lectures supported by workshop-style activities, including the discussion of cases, simulations and action learning projects.

The programme is open to domestic students only. You will need a recognised bachelors degree with a minimum GPA of 5.0 and at least three years' relevant management experience to be eligible to apply.
