

DOCTORAL SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY IN PHYSICAL EDUCATION

A one-time doctoral scholarship is available for an outstanding full-time applicant in the field of physical education.



The successful applicant will undertake a PhD thesis supervised within the Richard Tinning Research Unit (RTRU) that aims to make a positive contribution to the strategic research goals of the unit.

The ideal research focus may include topics such as:

- Pedagogical practices for social justice, equity, diversity and inclusion in physical education.
- Understanding the media cultures and practices of young people sourcing, producing and sharing information about their health
- Learning experiences that promote sustainable practices, develop healthy behaviors, and build resilience towards environmental and social challenges
- Games-based approaches to promoting active play and movement development

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

- Scholarship valued at \$33,000 p.a. plus compulsory fees for up to 36 months full-time study
- Available to domestic students and domestic fee-paying international students
- Paid work may not exceed 750 hours per 12-month period of scholarship tenure
- Applicants who already have a doctorate are not eligible for consideration
