GENERAL EDUCATION

Should you not have taken your General Education course yet:

You may take ENGLISH 121G or any other General Education course available from the appropriate schedules, i.e. either the Open schedule or the Education and Social Work schedule - see details following.

Go to www.auckland.ac.nz/uoa/cs-general-education to find out what General Education courses are available. Choose a course that does not clash with your BEd(Tchg) ECE timetable. Please allow for travelling time if the course you select is taught at the City campus.

Only courses with the **G suffix** from the Open and Education & Social Work Schedules satisfy the General Education requirement. Also note that you must select courses from outside of your degree area (i.e. no identical course codes e.g. EDUC 100G and EDUC 114)

General Education is also available in Summer School 2021.

Repeating course(s)

If you need to repeat a course(s) for the third time or if there are possible enrolment clashes with practicum placement please contact the Education Student Centre on education@auckland.ac.nz.

Please note that there is a specific form available at the Education Student Centre when requesting third time repeat approval. Completed applications need to be **submitted at least one month before semester starts** to allow for processing time.
